CITRUS TAR & ASPHALT REMOVER

Hazard:

- Causes mild skin irritation.
- May cause respiratory irritation.
- Causes serious eye irritation.
- Harmful if swallowed and enters airways.
- Combustible liquid.

WASHING PROCEDURES

- Use full strength, do not dilute.
- Apply generously to tar or oil deposit with spray bottle or cloth. Work into deposit with cloth or brush. Rinse with water or soapy solution.

ADHESIVE REMOVAL

- Use same procedure as with tar and oil, however, adhesive is more easily removed when temperature is above 70° F.



Warning

Storage:

- Keep product locked up and away from flames.

Disposal:

- Dispose of contents/container at an approved disposal plant.

Precautionary Statements: Prevention

- Wear protective gloves and eye protection.
- Avoid breathing mist and vapor.
- Use only in well-ventilated area.
- Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling.
- Keep away from heat/sparks/open flames/hot surfaces-NO smoking.
- Keep container tightly closed.

Response (First Aid)

- IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. If eye irritation persists: Get medical attention.
- IF ON SKIN (or HAIR): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water.
- IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.
- IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER. DO NOT induce vomiting.
